When 14-year-old Irene Sauvelle moves with her family to Cape House on the coast of Normandy in the 1930s, she's immediately taken by the beauty of the place its expansive cliffs, coasts, and harbors and when she meets a local boy named Ishmael, the two fall in love. But a dark mystery is about to unfold, involving a reclusive toymaker in a mansion full of secrets, a dream of a monster in the forest, and a demonic force that soon claims a life.
